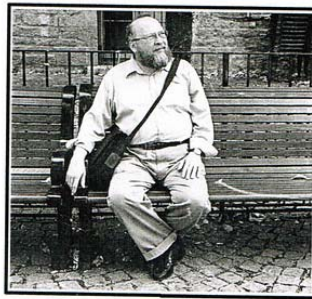

**The Rev'd Dr. William (Bill) Craig,** passed away on December 23rd suddenly at his home in Toronto in his 55th. Bill was a priest in our diocese, interim Priest-in-Charge at The Church of St. Columba & All Hallows, East York, a Church Historian, Public Orator, and professor at the Faculty of Divinity, Trinity College, University of Toronto. 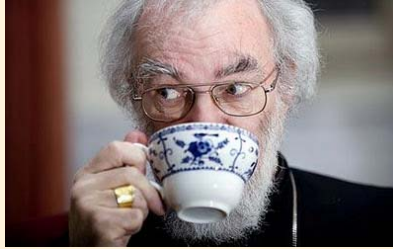
